

Appendix 1. Vascular plant species known to occur in the Bammert Farm conservation area. Survey dates in 2013 were 27 May; 2, 12, and 23 July; 13 August; 5 and 13 September. I primarily used Voss and Reznicek (2012) for species names. I listed one or two common names for the species below (some species have multiple common names). Asterisked species are non-native species. Species with an exclamation point are those that are newly documented in Keweenaw County or have been found on Isle Royale, but not on the Keweenaw mainland.
